products they need to be healthy and confident. Thank you Availity, Natural Life, Honey Pot and Feeding Northeast Florida – an amazing collaboration for good!





Grateful for Our Periods???

Halloween is behind us and Thanksgiving is on the horizon! The holidays are a time when we reflect on the things, people and experiences for which we are grateful. Yet, one thing never makes the list - our periods! Yes, you read correctly. Those pesky 3-7 days each month of menstruation. There is a silver lining. Women's Health providers consider the menstrual cycle a vital sign and a part of the objective data we interpret to measure your health. Particularly, a regular, once a month period is typically an indicator of an intact hormonal system and a structurally normal uterus.



Still not convinced that your period is a worthwhile point of gratitude? Well, let me explain further. Appropriately functioning premenopausal hormones are an integral part of producing a regular period and also maintaining bone health, mental and neurological health, and cardiovascular health. And it indicates a healthy reproductive system and the potential for fertility. Estrogen levels that are at normal values (which is assumed if periods are regular), prevent low bone density, Alzheimer's Disease, and cardiovascular events such as heart attacks and strokes. Women who are no longer having periods take precautions to prevent compromises to their health. As it relates to fertility, a regular period usually indicates that there is ovulation which is a prerequisite to natural conception. Therefore, for those who desire future fertility, having a cycle each month is a reassuring part of your gynecologic history.

A cycle that is also of normal flow and not excessively heavy is another indication of a structurally normal reproductive system.

So, even though it may feel like an untimely interruption in your normal activities each month, take the time to recognize that having a period is a healthy part of your body's physical state. You don't have to bring it up at the table over turkey, but you can add your gynecologic health to the list of things you are grateful for this year!
