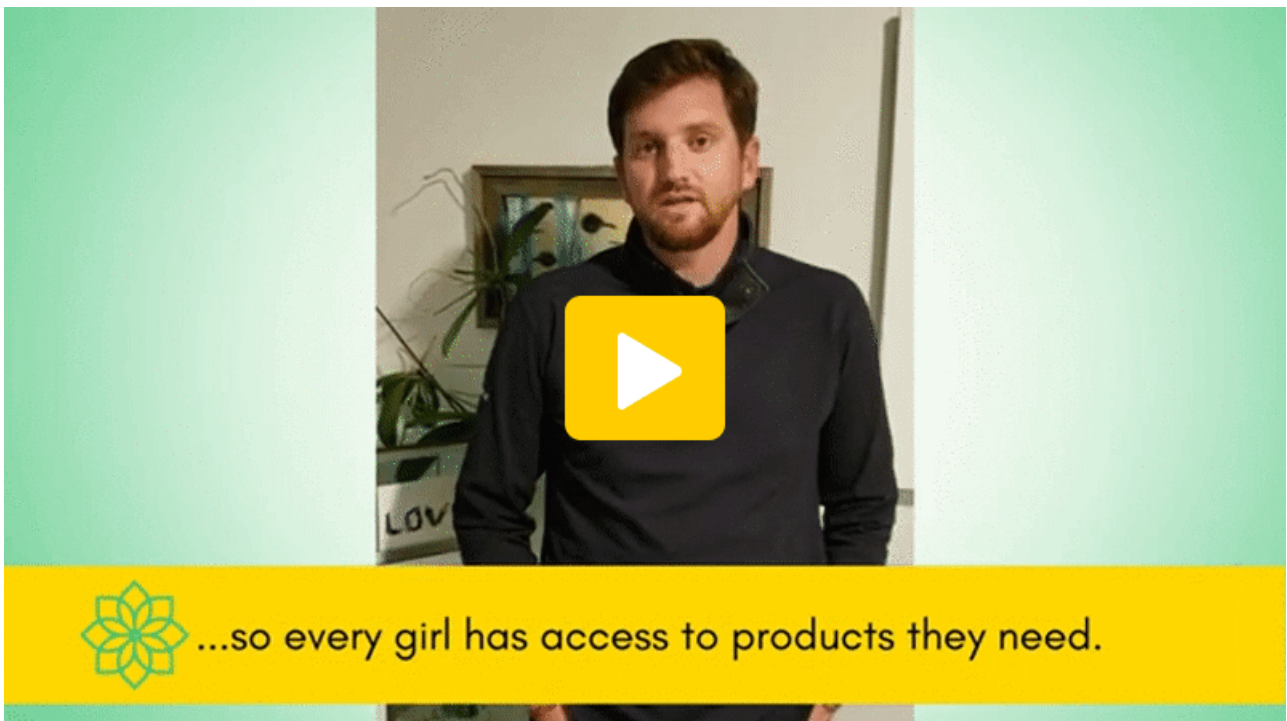

Renewing Dignity supports the current Learning with Dignity bills under



consideration in the Florida Legislature. One in five students miss school because they lack access to period supplies. This legislation will help girls stay in school paving the way for growth and success. SB 334 and HB 389 require that period supplies are available in Florida's public middle and high school bathrooms. Thirteen States have passed similar laws. We urge you to contact your legislators in support of
