



CS/HB 389: Menstrual Hygiene Products in Public Schools UNANIMOUSLY PASSES the Florida House and Senate!

Both chambers of the Florida legislature passed CS/HB 389: Menstrual Hygiene Products in Public Schools as the session closed last week! This bill authorizes school districts to make menstrual hygiene products available, at no charge, in schools within district and at certain locations within such schools; provides notification requirements; and encourages school districts to partner with specified organizations for specified purposes. With the Governor's signature, this bill will become law!

While this bill "authorizes" and does not "require" school districts to provide these menstrual supplies, we believe that this is a significant step forward for students' health, welfare, and dignity. This issue is now on the radar of all school administrators and the State of Florida.

Thank you to all that worked so hard to ensure that all Florida students will have access to the period supplies they need to attend class and participate fully in

school activities. Special thanks to Representative Kelly Skidmore and all that sponsored and voted for the bill.

Next Step: The Governor's Desk to Sign into Law!
